Starting 2020 with a balance of £10652.40 no one expected the year to be quite so unusual. Anyway, at the beginning of the year, 66 memberships came in to set us going. We enjoyed one of our Sunday lunches in January which produced a profit of £390.03 and the 200 Club contributed £850.50 from its activities in 2019. After this bright start and plans being made for our visit to La Chaussee Saint Victor later in the year we entered "Covid Lockdown" and of course, shutdown! Miscellaneous expenses were incurred during the year for our Website subscription for 2020 & 2021, the Broadland Lottery License fee for 2021 and NATC Insurance cover for 2020/21. We also spent £159.00 on a 20th Anniversary gift for La Chaussee Saint Victor which has obviously not yet been given.
